Description of activities	<p>The aim is to create a video in English that could be used by partners, giving instructions for assembly, perhaps including warnings.</p> <p>The main challenge is to propose a document that is clear, sounding as natural as possible in English.</p> <p>The students observe an extract from a component maintenance manual and focus on the characteristics in terms of layout and vocabulary.</p> <p>Then, they learn vocabulary of different tools and necessary materials by matching pictures and words.</p> <p>They prepare their oral presentation by creating a mind map with key words and they also practise the pronunciation of those keywords.</p> <p>They finally record their voice onto the Powerpoint presentation that was previously done by their classmates. The students vote to select the best presentation.</p>
Learning outcomes	<p>The students were quite confident because they started with a document they were already familiar with.</p> <p>They used link words to present a process in context.</p> <p>The use of Quizlet for the preparation of the presentation was rather positive because the students not only learnt the words more easily but could correct pronunciation mistakes in autonomy.</p> <p>This task was rewarding to them because they got the feeling their efforts were worthwhile since their video may be helpful to other students.</p>
